2.a Community Garden

The plan is to have kids paint small pots and plant a seed as a Mother's Day gift. Items the Town needs to purchase are as follows:

- Containers
- Seeds
- Soil
- Paint

This is also an opportunity to pass out fliers for upcoming events and to see if we can get four interested individuals/families who want to participate in the Community Garden.

2.b Fishing Derby

The Fishing Derby is set and ready to go. We have submitted the form for Colorado Parks and Wildlife, and they will bring most of the volunteers we need. This is one event that Judy has years of experience in and can help organize most of the logistics.

2.c Memorial Day BBQ

This is a low-key event. The only real logistics are buying food (purchase for 100, expect half that number), and bring as many of the outdoor event games and items that we can from bean bag toss to horseshoes, to three-legged races, gunny-sack races, tug-of-war, chalk, the barbecue grill, and others. Whether there is anything "official" is up to the Committee.

2.d Transition to Part-Time Recreation and Event Coordinator

Assistant to the Town Manager, Matt Hirschinger, will have his last day for the Town of Hudson on April 16th. This is due to the projects the position was designed for (Rec Center Analysis, Broadband, Emergency Operations Plan, other medium-and-small projects) have been completed, and there are other staffing needs. The position will be replaced by two part-time rolls, the first of which is a "Part-Time Office Payroll and Benefits Technician" the second which is a "Part-Time Recreation and Event Coordinator". The latter job description is included.

Once hired, there will of course be a transitional period as the new staff member becomes acquainted with the Town, its policies, and its history with rec and events. Once established, this role should be an improvement to the Town's recreation and events as the position is slated to be 20-24 hours a week, which is more than what the Assistant to the Town Manager role spent on an average week on recreation and events. Furthermore, this new role will be able to focus on recreation and events as opposed to being pulled in a few different directions.
