1. CONSENT AGENDA

- a. Recreation and Events Committee Minutes – June 9, 2021

College for Kids – Sophia sent survey about the experience to both the kids and parents. So far, she has no responses back.

d. Upcoming events finalization

Bike Rodeo – The rodeo will be held on July 24 from 8:00 a.m. to Noon for ages ranging from 5 to 11. It will be held in the town hall parking lot. The police department will be taking lead on this event.

There was a discussion about the town buying helmet for the kids as Sophia is having trouble finding anyone to sponsor the event. It was also discussed about purchasing reflective bicycle tape.

Motion was made by Committee Member McGill, seconded by Chavez “To purchase 30 kids helmets, 7 rolls of reflective tape for a total of \$192.49 plus shipping.”

Motion was made by Committee Member McGill, seconded by Committee Member Lang “To purchase an oil popcorn machine with cart for \$233.19 plus shipping from Home Depot.”

Volunteer Programming - Application, permission form and waiver have all been approved by town attorney.

Sophia have been looking at new ADA shuttle buses in the Denver area. We would like to stay with a shuffle bus that wouldn't require the drive to have an ADA license.

Open Gym – At the August meeting we will discuss what we want to do about open gym.

Fall line up – Harvest Fest is an event we need about a year to plan. We will start planning for next year.

Trunk 'n Treat – We will be having this event on Halloween October 31 which is a Sunday this year. Sophia and Judy will get together and order items to put into give away bags. We will need to get some candy.

We will have Santa this year for the kids to talk with. We will look into having a parade down Beech Street. As in previous years there will be cookies and punch, bags for Santa to hand out to the kids. We will try and get a choir from school to sing before lighting the town hall lights.




