We will continue with movie night with one movie in June, July and August. It was decided to contact the company who showed the movies and see about a contract for next year.

We will continue with Yard of the Month the same as this year. We will accept nominates from citizens and will have the judges consider them.

We will have the bike rodeo in the spring before school is out. We will look into the possibility of have Safety night out at the same time.

It was decided to have Sophia check into the price of new cornhole board, horseshoe equipment and spike ball equipment.

d. Events for Fall and Winter

i. Clean Up Days

Clean up days are September 17th and 18th. IT is a Public Works program, and they do everything in connection with it.

ii. Shred Event

The shred event will be September 24th from 800 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Sophia asked if anyone could help, and Judy McGill stated she could help.




