Section 8-35 of the Hudson Municipal Code prohibits the use of non-residential Town streets by overweight vehicles as defined by CRS §§ 42-4-507 and 42-4-508 unless a permit has been obtained from the Town. A Town permit is required for vehicles that require a permit from the State of Colorado.

I understand that according to Sec. 8-35 of the Hudson Municipal Code, subject to the exceptions listed below, an Overweight Vehicle Permit ("Permit") shall be required for any vehicle, as defined by C.R.S. §§ 42-4-507 and 42-4-508, for the use of any non-residential Town roadways (understanding, exclusive of State Highway 52 and Interstate 76:			
(1) Said permit, when required, shall be obtained from the Town prior to the transport of any vehicle within the Town that exceeds defined weight limits. (2) The Permit applicant or holder remains responsible to secure any additional transport permits that may be required for oversize and/or overweight vehicles that are not under the jurisdiction of the Town of Hudson. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to Weld County and the State of Colorado. (3) Any road damage occurring as a result of transport of an overweight vehicle within the Town shall be the financial responsibility of the permittee. (4) For vehicles exceeding 200,000 pounds, a bond in the amount determined by the Town Administrator or designee shall be posted as security prior to issuance of the Permit. The minimum bond shall be \$2,500 for security. Alternatively, the Permit applicant may provide proof of insurance in an amount deemed sufficient by the Town Engineer, or designee, and such insurance shall list the Town as an additional insured. (5) An Overweight Vehicle Permit shall NOT authorize use of residential town roadways by such vehicles.
