**20. Please write your thoughts on other issues concerning the Town that were not covered in the survey. Also, please share your thoughts on how to improve the survey in the future.**

- I only see room for growth on the west of I76. I like the survey the way it is.
- Growth on the eastern plains, keeping water for ag a top priority, manage traffic. Maintaining small town feel is important to me.
- Right now my biggest concern is the water bill. I honestly can't afford that and can't pay other bills due to water bill. Find a solution please.
- I feel if the town and community work as a team it will grow together, not apart. Like traffic on 52. The people who own the land next to Love's should think about selling it so that the trucks have a place to park. Stop giving them tickets. The grocery store needs to stay open late for people who don't get to town till 6 pm because of traffic and jobs.
- The alleys are a mess. People do not cut their weeds and I feel that should be the responsibility of the Town. Also put down recycled asphalt in alleys. Bindweed is out of control, so are mosquitos. There are numerous dead trees. Could you see about a contract with a tree trimming company to cut down all the dead trees in town for a discounted price?
- We would like better quality water. We don't like worrying about whether it is safe to drink or not.
- Code enforcement is doing a terrible job and the town has never looked worse. The town workers do not complete jobs. None of the dead-end streets have been swept in over a year. The green belt between Hudson Hills and the town is not maintained and is a fire danger. We are a growing community and if we want to attract business things need to get cleaned up
- More community involvement. Never have seen the chamber of commerce be proactive. As a former C of C director this is essential.
- Payment – have an averaging system for paying utility bill so it is not so expensive in the summer compared to winter. Should not be a processing fee for using a debit card online. It is a burden to bring payment town hall. There is no recurring payment system without fees or an app to easily pay.

- Oil and gas companies to drill well away from housing communities. If not, then the town needs to be more responsible of when they plan new residential areas so that they are very far from the drilling.
- Improvements made to the park, fence around the back side of the playground. More shade, new grills, another gazebo? For the survey, and online survey
- The survey covered almost everything. I do believe traffic is a bit much and drivers are being rude. They will jump to the side to bypass everyone in front of the Barn store. Are food inspections done regularly? I've seen some thing that made me question if the workers knew about food safety.
- Is it still possible to have someone come into Hudson for document shredding? In the past, we have had some group come in for electronic recycling. Is that possible?
- How about making the Print bigger? Some of us are not as young as we used to be.
- Post office boxes on the corner of each neighborhood.
- Please add cable internet to the town.
- I lived in Cortland, IL a very small town with a RR crossing. After 10 pm the trains coming did not sound their horns. There were signs stating this at crossings. Can this be done here? If so, I think it would go a long way with improving and growing the town's population.
- Have a 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration
- Clean up downtown area, keep it business centered not residential
- Train noise, is there anything we can do to improve that?
