

ORDINANCE NO. ~~1~~

Concerning Weeds and Rank Vegetation.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, State of Colorado: ~~newly or place used as a walk, and parking, adjoining an~~ Section 1. All persons owning, occupying or having under their control, any lot or lots or tract of real estate within the Town of Hudson, are hereby and hereafter required to cut and destroy or remove from said premises during the month of August and on or before the first day of September of each and every year hereafter, all weeds and rank vegetation not used or to be used for food or clothing for man or beast.

Section 2. The Town Marshal may order or direct the cleaning of any such place and the removal or destruction of such weeds and vegetation. Every person being the owner, agent or occupant of such premises who shall, within forty-eight hours after being duly notified by said Town Marshal, fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any such order to cut and destroy or remove such weeds or vegetation, shall be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars and costs; and the Board of Trustees of said Town may cause such weeds or vegetation to be cut and destroyed or removed, and shall assess the expense of so doing against the lot or premises upon which same may be found. In case the owner of said lot or premises shall fail to pay or cause to be paid said assessment within ten days after said assessment has been so made, the Board of Trustees may and shall instruct the Town Clerk to certify the amount of said assessment to the County Treasurer of Weld County for collection in the same manner as other taxes are collected. Provided, that said Board of Trustees may order the clerk to collect same by an action at law. In case any lot or premises having thereon any of the foregoing weeds or rank vegetation shall be owned or controlled by a person not a resident of this town, said Board of Trustees may have the same cut and removed or destroyed without serving personal notice upon the owner or person in control thereof, and may assess the cost thereof against said lot or premises as aforesaid.

All the provisions of this section affecting any lot or premise shall also apply to the sidewalk or place used as a walk, and parking, adjoining and abutting upon said lot or premise.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson hereby finds and ~~de~~ declares this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
