TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT EFFECTIVE WITH THE APPOINTMENT OF THE NEXT MAYOR PRO TEM FOLLOWING THE NEXT BIENNIAL ELECTION, THE MAYOR PRO TEM SHALL BE COMPENSATED AT THE MAYOR'S RATE OF PAY FOR THOSE MEETINGS AT WHICH THE MAYOR PRO TEM PERFORMS THE MAYOR'S DUTIES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 97-12 established the compensation to be paid to the Mayor and Board of Trustees, which compensation is to be paid on a pro rata basis for meetings actually attended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to provide that the compensation paid to the Mayor Pro Tem when he is required to preside over a meeting in the Mayor's absence be paid at the Mayor's rate of compensation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. Effective following the appointment of the Mayor Pro Tem following the April 2002, regular municipal election, the Mayor Pro Tem shall be paid at the Mayor's rate of pay, instead of at the rate of trustee, for any regular meeting at which the Mayor Pro Tem presides over in the Mayor's absence.

Section 2. Safety Clause. The Town Board of Trustees hereby finds, determines, and declares that this ordinance is promulgated under the general police power of the Town of Hudson, that it is promulgated for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of health and safety and for the protection of public convenience and welfare. The Board of Trustees further determines that the ordinance bears a rational relation to the proper legislative object sought to be attained.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final publication.
