TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO

A RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVY

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1991, TO HELP DEFRAID THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, FOR THE 1992 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 11, 1991; and,

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$45,773; and,

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for bonds and interest is \$23,000; and,

WHEREAS, the 1991 valuation for assessment for the Town of Hudson, Colorado, as certified by the County Assessor is \$3,210,770.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, during the 1992 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 14.377 mills

upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town
for the year 1991.

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of meeting all bonds and interest of the Town of Hudson, Colorado during the 1992 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 7.163 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 1991.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor and Town Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, the mill levy for the Town of Hudson, Colorado as hereinabove determined and set.
