TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO

A RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVY

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1993, TO HELP DEFRAID THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, FOR THE 1994 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 8, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$44,267; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for bonds, interest and debt is \$49,159; and

WHEREAS, the 1993 valuation for assessment for the Town of Hudson, Colorado, as certified by the County Assessor is \$3,078,990.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, during the 1994 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 14.377 mills

upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town
for the year 1993.

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of meeting all bonds, interest and debt of the Town of Hudson, Colorado during the 1994 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 15.996 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 1993.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor and Town Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, the mill levy for the Town of Hudson, Colorado as hereinabove determined and set.
