**TITLE: A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION TO GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO FOR MATCHING GRANT FUNDS.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the public interest to upgrade the deteriorated facilities at the Hudson Town Park; and

WHEREAS, the Great Outdoors Colorado manages a program that provides matching grants to assist in improving outdoor recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town, in cooperation with the Hudson Elementary School and the Colorado Department of Local Affairs, has prepared a master plan for improving the Hudson Town Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Town Administrator are authorized to submit an application to the State Board of Great Outdoors Colorado for a grant in the amount of \$129,234.00.

Section 2. That the Town Administrator is directed to include for consideration in the proposed 2008 Town of Hudson budget funds in the amount of \$63,788 from the Conservation Trust Fund and from the Sales Tax Capital Fund to match the grant.
