**TITLE: A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE PREVIOUS CALL OF A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR NOVEMBER 3, 2009, SUBMITTING BALLOT QUESTIONS TO THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON AT SAID ELECTION, AND SETTING THE BALLOT TITLES THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined to participate in the November 3, 2009 coordinated election, and present certain ballot questions to the registered electors of the Town of Hudson;

WHEREAS, according to Article X, Section 20, of Colorado Constitution, ballot issues pursuant to the provisions of to Article X, Section 20 of Colorado Constitution shall be decided at biennial local district elections or at elections held on the first Tuesday in November of odd-numbered years, and thus Ballot Issue No. 1 as set forth below is to be presented at the November 3, 2009 coordinated election;

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-20-202(1.5), any eligible city or town may determine at a regular or special election not to publish their proceedings relating to payment of Town bills and statements concerning Town contracts, and in order to reduce the costs of publishing, the Town of Hudson desires to submit a question to the registered electors to determine whether the Town may be authorized not to publish their proceedings relating to the payment of Town bills and statements concerning Town contracts, and thus Ballot Issue No. 2 as set forth below is to be presented at the November 3, 2009 coordinated election; and

WHEREAS, any municipality may determine at a regular or special election to meet the requirements of C.R.S. § 31-16-105 by publishing ordinances by title only rather than by publishing the ordinance in full, and in order to reduce the costs of publishing, the Town of Hudson desires to submit a question to the registered electors to determine whether the Town may publish its ordinances by title only rather than by publishing its ordinances in full., and thus Ballot Issue No. 3 as set forth below is to be presented at the November 3, 2009 coordinated election

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees hereby calls a special election for Tuesday November 3, 2009, which election shall be coordinated with Weld County.

Section 2. At the special election of Tuesday, November 3, 2009, the following ballot issues shall be submitted to the registered electors of the Town of Hudson, Colorado:

Ballot Issue 1.

WITHOUT RAISING TAXES, SHALL THE TOWN OF HUDSON BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND EXPEND THE FULL PROCEEDS GENERATED BY ANY REVENUE SOURCE OF THE TOWN NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LIMITATION CONTAINED IN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION AND WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED AND SPENT BY THE TOWN UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION?

Ballot Issue 2.

SHALL THE TOWN OF HUDSON BE AUTHORIZED TO NO LONGER PUBLISH THE PAYMENT OF BILLS AND THE AWARD OF TOWN CONTRACTS AND REBATES IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE TOWN THEREBY SUBSTANTIALLY REDUCING THE COST INCURRED IN PUBLICATION?

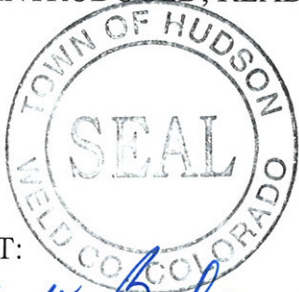
Ballot Issue 3.
