**TITLE: A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A FEDERAL
TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROJECT GRANT
APPLICATION.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Hudson is requesting federal funding for transportation enhancements along State Highway 52, between Juniper and Beech Streets, in the form of a pedestrian / bicycle sidewalk.

WHEREAS, Upper Front Range Transportation Planning Region #4 Office and the Colorado Department of Transportation requires that the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson state its support for the Federal Transportation Enhancement Projects grant application for a SH 52 pedestrian / bicycle sidewalk between Juniper and Beech Streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

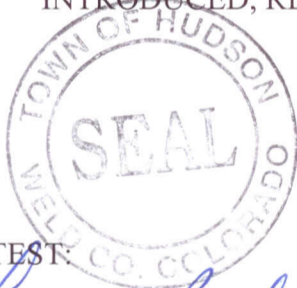
Section 1. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson strongly supports the application to the Upper Front Range Transportation Planning Region #4 Office and the Colorado Department of Transportation for a pedestrian / bicycle sidewalk along SH 52 between Juniper and Beech Street.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson acknowledges that the grant application includes matching funds which the Town of Hudson is solely responsible to provide if a grant is awarded.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson will appropriate those matching funds and authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any Grant awarded.
