**TITLE:** A RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY CANCELLING THE TOWN'S  
APRIL 3, 2012, REGULAR ELECTION

WHEREAS, Section 2-11(c) of the Hudson Municipal Code and C.R.S. § 31-10-507 provides for cancellation of the election if the only matter before voters is the election of candidates to office and if, as of close of business on the 19<sup>th</sup> day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including write-in candidates filing affidavits of intent pursuant to Section 2-11(b) of the Hudson Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the 19<sup>th</sup> day before the election is Thursday, March 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, at the April 3, 2012, election, three (3) Trustee seats are to be filled; and

WHEREAS, as of the date of the consideration of this Resolution, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled, including write-in candidates filing affidavits of intent; and

WHEREAS, the Board would like to conditionally cancel the April 3, 2012, election, as permitted by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. If, after the close of business on Thursday, March 15, 2012, there is not more than three (3) candidates for the Board of Trustees, including write-in candidates filing affidavits of intent, the Board of Trustees directs the Town Clerk as the Town's designated election official to cancel the April 3, 2012, Town of Hudson municipal election.

Section 2. In the event that the election is cancelled, the Town Clerk is directed to provide public notice of the cancellation of the election pursuant to the Hudson Municipal Code.

Section 3. In accordance with C.R.S. § 31-4-301(3), and in order to retain a quorum, the remaining Trustees holding seats unfilled in this election shall remain in office until their successors are elected and qualified by appointment pursuant to Section 2-2 of the Hudson Municipal Code.
