ORDINANCE NO. 31  
of  
THE TOWN OF HUDSON  
WELD COUNTY  
COLORADO

(Introduced by Trustee W. Marshall)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON,  
COUNTY OF WELD, STATE OF COLORADO:

That the following described portion of what is known  
as Ash Street in the Town of Hudson, County of Weld, State of  
Colorado, be and the same is hereby vacated, to-wit:

\*The west fifteen (15) feet of Ash Street from the inter-  
section of Main Street north to the east line of the  
right of way of the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad  
Company, according to the map of the Town of Hudson on  
file in the office of the Clerk and Recorder of Weld County,  
Colorado.\*

That hereafter said Ash Street along the line of said  
vacation shall have a total width of forty-five (45) feet.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force

from and after its publication once in The Hudson News.

Ordained by the Board of Trustees and signed and ap-  
proved by the Mayor of the Town of Hudson, County of Weld, State  
of Colorado, this 11th day of September, A. D. 1935.
