

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY RUNNING EAST AND WEST ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF LOTS TEN (10) AND TWENTY-SIX (26) IN BLOCK THIRTY-FOUR (34), TOWN OF HUDSON AND THAT PORTION OF THE ALLEY RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH THROUGH SAID BLOCK THIRTY-FOUR (34), TWENTY-FIVE FEET IN LENGTH, LYING NORTH OF A LINE ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-NINE (159) FEET NORTH OF THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID ALLEY, AS ORIGINALLY LOCATED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO.

SECTION I.

In consideration of the agreement of Foster Lumber Company, a Corporation, to open and dedicate an alley running East and West from the East line of lot Nine (9) in Block Thirty-four (34), Town of Hudson, along the North side of Lot Twenty-five (25) in said Block, the following described alley and portions of an alley now existing in said Block Thirty-four (34) are hereby declared vacated, to-wit:

That certain alley running East and West through said Block Thirty-four (34) along the North side of Lots ten (10) and Twenty-six (26) of said Block; and that portion of the alley running North and South through said Block, Twenty-five (25) feet in length, lying North of a line across said alley which is One Hundred and Fifty-nine (159) feet North of the Southern boundary thereof, as originally located.

SECTION II.

It is hereby declared that the above alley and portion thereof so vacated are not essential to public convenience and necessity, and the Town of Hudson relinquishes title thereto.

ORDINANCE NO. 40.
