

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY YEARS THE FRANCHISE ORIGINALLY GRANTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 26 PASSED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OF SAID TOWN ON JUNE 5, 1919, TO W. C. STERNE, HIS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, WHICH SAID FRANCHISE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED TO AND IS NOW HELD BY THE COLORADO CENTRAL POWER COMPANY, A CORPORATION:

Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, County of Weld, State of Colorado:

Section 1. That the franchise granted by Ordinance No. 26 passed by the Board of Trustees of the said Town of Hudson and approved by the Mayor thereof on June 5, 1919, to W. C. Sterne, his successors and assigns, for a period of twenty-five years, now held by the Colorado Central Power Company, a corporation, granting the right and privilege to install, extend, maintain, and operate an electric plant or system in the said Town of Hudson for the supply, distribution and sale of electricity in said Town of Hudson, be and same is hereby extended for a period of twenty years beyond and in addition to the period for which said franchise originally was granted.

Section 2. WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final publication.
