ORDINANCE NO. 44

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF ASH STREET IN THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described portion of Ash Street in the Town of Hudson, Colorado, has heretofore been duly platted and dedicated to the public, but has never been opened or used and is not necessary to the convenience of the public, therefore the closing and vacating thereof will work no injury to private rights, and,

WHEREAS, the owners of the abutting lots and lands have made request, and it is deemed to the public interest and to the interest of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, that said portion of said Street be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO:

Section I. That the following described Street, to-wit:

All of that portion of Ash Street lying No. 6 in the Town of Hudson, Weld County,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section II. In the opinion of the Town Board an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.

ORDINANCE NO. 44

All of that portion of Ash Street lying North of Highway No. 6 in the Town of Hudson, Weld County, Colorado,

be and the same is hereby vacated.
