

1 ORDINANCE RELATING TO STATE HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN OF HUDSON;  
2 PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN TRAFFIC REGULATIONS THEREON; DEDICATING CERTAIN  
3 PORTIONS OF THE CITY STREETS TO THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF COLORADO AS  
4 PARTS OF STATE HIGHWAYS NO. 52 AND 2; AND RECOGNIZING THE RIGHT OF THE  
5 DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN  
6 THE SAME.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON:

8 Section 1.

9 That the public necessity and convenience requires the  
10 construction of a new highway through the Town of Hudson, which highway has  
11 been constructed according to the plans and specifications of Colorado Depart-  
12 ment of Highways Project No. F 003-1(2).

13 Section 2.

14 That where these highways traverse or cross through  
15 streets, said portions of these streets are hereby dedicated to the people of  
16 the State of Colorado as connecting links in and as a part of Colorado State  
17 Highways No. 52 and 2; that this Ordinance shall constitute an agreement on  
18 behalf of the Town with the Colorado Department of Highways that the said  
19 portions of the said streets shall be included in said State Highways No.  
20 52 and 2 as necessary and convenient connecting links for carrying such High-  
21 ways through said Town subject to relocation or abandonment as provided by  
22 Law for State Highways.

23 Section 3. That State Highway No. 2 as constructed or improved,  
24 or as the same may be removed or relocated shall always remain a through  
25 Street within the limits of said Town.

26 Section 4. That on no portion of any State Highway or connecting  
27 link in said Town shall any person violate any of the provisions of Chapter 13,  
28 CRS, (1953), or any of the laws amending the same, or any of the rules or  
29 Regulations issued in pursuance thereof.

30 Section 5. That parking is hereby prohibited at all points along  
31 said State Highway No. 2. That parking on State Highways, other than State  
32 Highway No. 2, when and where permitted shall be parallel or diagonal as  
33 provided by law for parallel and diagonal parking in the area where said types  
34 of parking are now established; that there shall be no parking whatsoever on any  
35 roadway or contiguous shoulder of any State Highway or connecting link within  
36 said Town during the times and at the place where snow removal operations are in  
37 progress.

1 SECTION 6. That upon the basis of engineering and traffic investig-  
2 tions by the Colorado Department of Highways, and by said Town, the reasonable  
3 and *trus prima facie* speed limit on State Highway No. 2 through said Town  
4 shall be 50 miles per hour, and that the reasonable and *trus prima facie*  
5 speed limit on State Highway No. 52 shall be 25 miles per hour,  
6 provided that standard signs are erected giving notice of the authorized  
7 speed as provided by Chapter 13, CRS, (1953).

8 SECTION 7. All traffic and parking regulations hereinafter adopted  
9 pertaining to the streets and roadways forming a part of the State Highway  
10 System or being a connecting link thereof shall be submitted to the Colorado  
11 Department of Highways for approval in accordance with the provisions of  
12 Chapter 202, Section 35 (d) Session Laws of Colorado 1953, before they shall  
13 become effective.

14 Section 8. That all parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are  
15 hereby repealed.

16 Section 9. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof  
17 to any person or circumstance is held invalid such invalidity shall not  
18 affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be  
19 given effect without the invalid provisions or applications and to this end  
20 the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

21 Section 10. That this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate pro-  
22 tection and preservation of the Public health, safety, convenience and general  
23 welfare and it is enacted for that purpose and shall be in force and effect  
24 immediately after passage of final publication.
